TO A BROADLY INTERDISCIPLINARY AUDIENCE AND, IF POSSIBLE, SHOULD  
BE SUBMITTED IN A FORM CLOSE TO THAT IN WHICH THEY WOULD BE DE-  
LIVERED. (A DETAILED OUTLINE--NOT MERELY A BRIEF ABSTRACT--WILL  
ALSO BE ACCEPTABLE.) PERSONS WISHING TO PROPOSE TOPICS FOR DIS-  
CUSSION GROUPS OR SPECIAL PANELS SHOULD SUBMIT AN OUTLINE DE-  
SCRIBING THE TOPIC AND LISTING THE MAJOR POINTS THEY WOULD HOPE  
TO COVER IN THE SESSION.

PAPERS AND PROPOSALS SHOULD BE SENT NO LATER THAN 1 DECEMBER  
1980, TO FREDERICK KIRCHHOFF, DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH AND LINGUIS-  
TICS, INDIANA UNIVERSITY-PURDUE UNIVERSITY AT FORT WAYNE,
