
- \* Winner: \$1500, plus \$250 in travel expenses and free registration for the 2024 MVSA conference

- \* A statement on research (maximum 3 single-space pages, 12-point font):

Please provide a brief overview of your dissertation topic, remembering that your proposal will be reviewed by faculty members in several disciplines. Indicate clearly the present state of your work and explain how an award would assist you in completing the dissertation (for example, partial travel support, purchase of library supplies, etc.);

- \* A current CV (maximum 2 pages single-spaced, 12-point font);
- \* TWO letters of reference; these must be submitted directly by recommenders to <u>arnsteinprize@midwestvictorian.org</u>.
